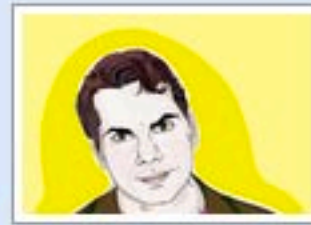

ART: In celebration of Amnesty International's sixtieth anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights (UDHR), a mural is being unveiled as part of "Project: Urban Canvas." The project came together under the leadership of the Art in Action team, along with consulting services donated by Mural Roules. The goal of the mural series—created by community members and artists armed with colourful palettes, not to mention heaps of creativity and enthusiasm—is to raise awareness about human rights violations that are occurring worldwide. The artwork at Midland Park is one of thirty murals across the city—some completed, others still in progress—representing the Articles in the UDHR.
